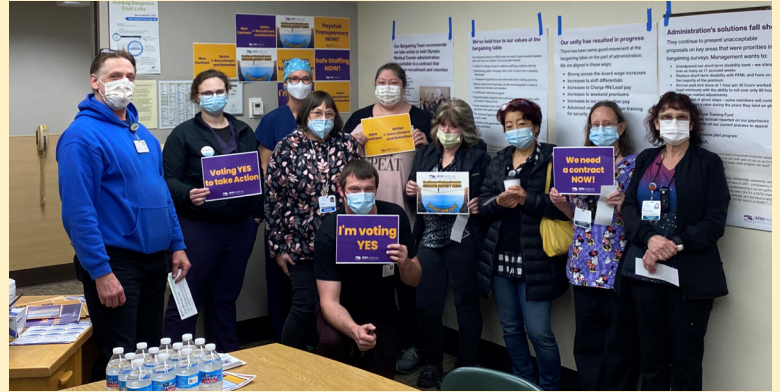




We voted overwhelmingly **YES** to take action!

The action vote results are in: a strong majority of us voted and we voted yes nearly unanimously! We have voted to take action in our community to win the contract we deserve. We know that our community has our back – and we’re ready to ask them to join our fight for a strong contract that includes no takeaways, transparent paystubs, and market adjustments that are competitive with area hospitals and address our staffing crisis at OMC.
