Management has spent millions of dollars on travelers - it's time they invest in their own employees!

These several months of negotiations have been, to say the least, a bit defeating for all of us. However, with this move we are hoping that management now sees, if they didn't before, we are ready and willing to secure a contract that reflects wage increases that keep up with the rising cost of living, and values us as employees by any means necessary.

We have given a fair opportunity to bargain in good faith but continue to feel overworked and taken advantage of because of our loyalty to this community. We all have made sacrifices, and now it's time to take action - talk to your bargaining team members to get the plan for public action next steps!"
