We fought and won! We will see another wage increase of 3% this year before we go back to the bargaining table next year.

UW Medicine CEO Cindy Hecker just reported that the vacancy rate at UWMC-Northwest has decreased. We know why — because the raises we won in our last contract reopener have helped retain and recruit healthcare workers in our facilities. But the cost of living has increased, and that is why it is critical that we harness our union strength ahead of our upcoming negotiations next year. A strong union membership means the power to reject the takeaways that UW Medicine administration will try to propose, just as they have proposed in their other facilities where they are bargaining new contracts now.
