

Celebrating the One-Year Anniversary of our Historic Coalition Contract: Across the Board Wage Increases Coming Soon

One year ago, **75,000** of our union siblings in the Coalition of Kaiser Permanente Unions walked out on a 3-day strike, making history as the largest healthcare worker strike in the US! Our unity, solidarity and 95% YES on a strike vote helped us win strong national and local agreements that uplifted retiree benefits, layoff benefits, and guaranteed significant wage increases throughout the life of the contract.

Our amazing across-the-board wages increases include 5% each year for the next 3 years! These raises ensure that members in every unit see meaningful increases throughout the life of the contract. The effective date for this year is October 6, which should be reflected on our October 25 paychecks.
