Montana is facing a nurse staffing crisis fueled by the high cost of living, an aging workforce, and low wages across our state. That's why we were very disappointed with Logan Health's rejection of our request to negotiate an additional mid-contract wage increase just like other employers across our union. Two years ago, we successfully opened bargaining early with mutual agreement. We can reopen bargaining early for wages, we just need Logan Health to agree to do the right thing.

We just had 2 weeks of sticker up actions to let management know that we are unified in our request to have a wage reopener!
